

STORMWATER REBATE TERMS & CONDITIONS

The Terms & Conditions detail the requirements of the applicants in the program. Applicants agree to these Terms & Conditions when submitting the application form.

- Property Owner and Tenant release the City of Palo Alto from, and assume all liability for, any losses, damages, injuries (including death), demands, claims, actions, or debts based upon or arising from participation in the Stormwater Rebate Program.
- 2. The City of Palo Alto reserves the right to change, modify or reduce rebate levels, as well as add or drop specific eligible measures at any time without prior notice.
- 3. City of Palo Alto disclaims any and all liability from any property damage or loss that may arise as a result of the applicant's or contractor's participation in this program.
- 4. City of Palo Alto shall not be responsible for claims regarding rebate amounts, program dates or guidelines made by contractors, retailers or other third parties. Final determination of rebate eligibility will be governed by the Terms and Conditions.
- 5. City of Palo Alto is neither responsible for items lost or delayed in the mail, nor any remittance delayed due to incorrect rebate applications. Incomplete applications cannot be processed and will be returned.
- 6. The Internal Revenue Service requires the City to issue an IRS Form 1099 (Miscellaneous Income) to rebate program participants receiving a total of \$600 or more in stormwater rebates from the City. This is only applicable to pervious pavement applicants who apply through the City's program.

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STORMWATER REBATE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

The checklist is designed to help applicants navigate the application and approval process. Applicants do not need to submit the checklist. It is best to complete the checklist in order.

Determine if your pervious pavement installation requires any permits before installation. Pervious Pavement may require permits or further pre-approval if:
□ The project is on a commercial site.
□ The project is greater than 2,500 square feet.
□ To inquire about permitting, contact the City <u>Development Center</u> at (650)-329-2496 and select Option 3 for Building Plan Check Team when prompted.
Schedule and execute a consultation with a contractor about your property.
 Decide which type of pervious pavement best suits your project based on your consultation.
□ Save any receipt or proof of payment for a contractor consultation.
 Hire a contractor to install this stormwater measure. (This installation will occur after receiving the "Notice to Proceed" from the City.)
Save receipts of any purchases made for the project including contracting services.
Complete the application form (online or hard copy)
Attach the following documents to the application.
 Installation plans (Blueprints or drawings of the installation property, any relevant property details)
□ A copy of permit(s) approval from the Development Center (if applicable)
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REQUIREMENTS FOR A PERVIOUS PAVEMENT REBATE

When purchasing and installing pervious pavement, applicants should be mindful of these requirements. The installation must meet these standards in order to receive a rebate. If these requirements are not met, applicants will be deemed ineligible to receive a rebate.

- 1. Pervious Pavement must be considered one of the following:
 - a. Porous Asphalt
 - b. Pervious Concrete
 - c. Permeable Interlocking Concrete Pavers (PICP)
 - d. Grid Pavement
- 2. Pervious pavement must be installed by an experienced, licensed contractor.
- 3. Pervious pavement must be at least 100 square feet in size.
- 4. Pervious pavement must not impede window egress of safe passage for travel.
- 5. Pervious pavement must have appropriate permits if it meets any permitting criteria. Please contact the <u>Development Center</u> at (650) 329-2496 and select Option 3 for the Building Plan Check Team when prompted.
- 6. Pervious pavement must not be installed before a "Notice to Proceed" has been issued by the City. Rebates will not be processed until all supporting documents, including permits, have been received.
- 7. Pervious pavement must not be previously rebated under any other program, including, but not limited to, those outside of the City of Palo Alto.
